GREETINGS FROM HOPE FOR HUMANITY ORGANISATION

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL YEAR HAS GONE BY AND HOPE FOR HUMANITY IS ALL SET TO HEAD INTO ITS 15 TH YEAR- SOMETHING THAT ALL OF US HAVE BEEN LOOKING FORWARD TO WITH A GREAT DEAL OF EXCITEMENT.

2011-2012 HAS BEEN A WONDERFUL YEAR FOR HOPE FOR HUMANITY- IN THE CLASSROOMS AND OUTSIDE THE CLASS ROOMS!

We started sponsoring the poor kids under Hope for Humanity Organization from the academic year 2009-2010 with a few number of 20. Gradually we started expanding our sponsorship to more than 100 kids. Being a private organization with the involvement in the Hope for Humanity Organization half of the kids became sponsored kids. Director of HOPE FOR HUMANITY public school became the Hope for Humanity Director. From these three years we started involving completely with Hope for Humanity Organization. We formed a Committee, registered the HfH Organisation in India, applied for FCRA and got temporary approval for three years. All this and every thing achieved under the guidance of Boppana Krishna garu, Founder and Director, HfH U.S.A., and the broad mindedness and kind hearts of our sponsors who works very hard for the upliftment of the Human race in their mother land. We worked for this project

very hard wandering through government offices for the Registration, FCRA approvals etc.

Let us brief the backgrounds of HfH kids. All the kids came from the Below Poverty line families. Most of the kids have single parents who work very hard for feeding these children. They came from the families where they struggle a lot for their bread and butter. On January 24th we had Annadanam programme in our school during our Director Boppana Krishna gari visit. On that day we cannot imagine the sad stories of our parents who cried a lot before of our director. The stories of the parents are so touching that all the staff, local and non local members felt that they had to work more harder than before for the uplift of not only HfH kids but also their parents.

The first batch of X class students who are sponsored by Hope for Humanity organization wrote their board examinations, are waiting for their results. Let us hope that they will fly with colors' with good results.

Government reports indicate that 59 million children between 6-14 years do not attend school. Official information further indicates that just a little over one-third of all children who enroll in grade one reach grade eight. And this in a country which has made education for children in the age group 6-14 years a fundamental right? Education charities from Hope for Humanity organization can potentially play a vital role in the country's development as educated children are the key to a bright future. Our sponsors help will go a long way in providing educational opportunities for children who would otherwise be left behind. For all this I thank all the sponsors for their continued support for the education in India, their mother land.

The core competency of HOPE FOR HUMANITY- 'academic excellence' continues to reign supreme. In an increasingly competitive world, knowledge empowerment continues to occupy centre state, even as we talk of 'holistic development'. There is no denying the importance of class room learning- especially conceptual understanding and a child's ability to convey this

understanding orally as well as writing. Therefore, the significance of teacher training, professional development and actual transaction of knowledge. The entire student body is going on to the next class, having added to their knowledge and skill sets and there is a sense of wondrous satisfaction all around. That said, we realize that there is always room for improvement and we will work towards that.



The pre-primary has, as always, laid focus on age appropriate learning. Skill building is as essential as gaining knowledge.

The primary section received a lot of kudos for the way the children have shaped up over the year. The programme followed was instrumental in the same and the teachers added more value to the students learning by supplementing this with additional worksheets. The staff feedback has seen addition of more written practice to help students become better learners in the years to come.

In 2011-2012, the secondary section had to put in some extra effort due to the school days lost on account of Annual day celebrations preparations. The students and the staff rose to the occasion and worked hard and smart to offset learning time that was lost. It has now stepped into the academic year 2012-2013 with a lot of anticipation.

In terms of staff we had very qualified and experienced staff who is very dedicated towards our HfH children. They are very hard working, we can see the results of their hard working nature in the performances of the HfH kids in the Annual day celebrations.

Staff has proven to be the most challenging aspect of this entire experience so far, however the attitudes of parents have also proved problematic in a minority of cases. We regret to report that 7 of our

children have left the school for a number of reasons. One of these is that the parents became worried that the children would become unmanageable due to being too highly educated, after only one year at our school! In other cases, some children had been sent to stay with relatives who live close to the school, and for whatever personal reasons this arrangement did not work out. Another reason was that we are very strict about the level of attainment children need in order to fit into a certain class. This is not popular with some parents, who often find that a child who may have been in class 3 at our school would be accepted into class 6 in the government school due to low standards, rendering the government school more attractive
